The Idaho Department of Lands (IDL) has begun aerial reviews of reclamation plans covered by traditional bonds and by the Bond Assurance Fund (BAF). Your reclamation plan was selected for review and a discrepancy was discovered between the disturbed acreage on record and the reclamation bond coverage.

The disturbed acreage of record was 30.0 acres. Based on aerial photography dated July 11, 2014, the disturbed acreage of the reclamation area is 99.6 acres. A map is included with this letter for reference.

Reclamation plan S02097 is currently bonded using the BAF. Because your reclamation plan is now over 40 acres, your bond must be in the form of a traditional reclamation bond. Please contact our office to discuss this transition. It is anticipated that this bond will be approximately \$248,900.00.
